**PUBLIC PORTION:**

Mr. Sam Sweet questioned the procedure for the workshop. He also asked about the capital budget.

1. **DISCUSSION OF NJDOT DISCRETIONARY AID PROGRAM “STATE AID” APPLICATIONS** – Mr. Cantwell explained that the application for this State Aid application is \$1,600.00 for Johnson Road from Honeysuckle Drive to Berlin-Cross Keys Road, a distance of 2,500 feet. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
2. **DISCUSSION OF 2018 CAPITAL BUDGET** – Mr. Cardis explained the Capital budget as well as the NJEIT budget and presented the bond ordinances to Council. The council questioned various items on the capital budget. The ordinances will be on the meeting Monday evening.
3. **DISCUSSION OF A TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FOR US VISION** – Mr. Carlamere stated that US Vision has a need to put two temporary trailers on their property for storage for a few months and Zoning denied this permit, as it must be approved by the Township Council. Mr. Carlamere stated that he will be reviewing the ordinance that governs this and will be preparing a resolution for Monday night’s meeting.
