WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Gloucester formally approves of the submitting of an electronic Application for Funding from the NJDOT Transportation Alternative Program for the Connector Trail along Lakeland Road, **FURTHERMORE**, the Council commits to the construction of and the maintenance of this project, and

WHEREAS, the project will connect the existing 2 mile long “Gloucester Township Health and Fitness trail” to both the Camden County Bike Sharing program in the commercial district along the Black Horse Pike (NJ Route 168) and

WHEREAS, this project will not only enhance the function of the County Bike Sharing program it will contribute to the development of the Black Horse Pike Commercial district,

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DRUG FREE ZONE MAP, CHAPTER 46A ENTITLED, "DRUG FREE SCHOOL ZONES" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Gloucester, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Drug Free Zone Map, Chapter 46A entitled "Drug Free School Zones" of the Code of the Township of Gloucester be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Drug Free Zone Map, Chapter 46A be and is hereby amended to include the following:

Public/Park Playground
Recreation Site:

1. **COBBLESTONE
BLOCK: 18310
LOT: 92**
2. **LITTLE GLOUCESTER RD. (FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER)
BLOCK: 13401
LOT: 3**
3. **CITIZENS APPRECIATION PARK (801 N. BLACK HORSE PIKE)
BLOCK: 1003
LOT: 6**
4. **HERITAGE PARK (201 SOMERDALE RD)
BLOCK: 3402
LOT: 1**

SECTION 2. All ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection or part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as required by law.
