

**GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
OCTOBER WORKSHOP**

OCTOBER 7, 2019

PUBLIC PORTION:

Mr. Mercado opened the public portion.

There being no comment, the public portion was closed.

1. **DISCUSSION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL TIMING DIRECTIVES** – Mr. Chadwell of Remington & Vernick stated the project at Peter Cheeseman Road and College Drive was completed under budget. The contractor offered several opportunities to utilize the remaining funds. One such option includes PTS signals at College Drive that would coordinate with signals at Erial Road and College Drive and Erial Road and Lil Gloucester, where the signals can communicate with each other. Traffic studies at Erial Road and College Drive and Erial Road and Lil Gloucester must be completed in order to provide the contractor with timing signal directives to coordinate all three traffic lights. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.

COUNCIL LIAISON REPORTS:

Mr. Owens stated all of the doors at the housing authority have been painted, the parking lots have been sealed and striped, a new gazebo installed, the concrete near door openings has been repaired, and Medicare changes for 2020 will be presented at the Senior Center.

Mr. Mercado stated this is fire prevention week and this Saturday is the Citizens' Appreciation Ceremony at 10:00 am. Mr. Mercado stated there is an agreement of sale for Rosalind Bridge that has been in the works. Mr. Caralere stated the township is in the process of obtaining Green Acres funds for settlement. Mr. Mercado asked if the man who brought this up at the last council meeting was aware that the township was already working on this. Mr. Caralere stated he believed Mr. Lechner relayed the information. Mr. Mercado stated the November workshop is being rescheduled to November 6 due to Deputy Chief Harkins being sworn in on Monday at Camden County College at 7:00 pm. Mr. Mercado stated there were no findings in the township's annual audit.

Mr. Cardis directed council to call him if there were any questions in regards to the audit, otherwise there will be a resolution to accept the audit at the next council meeting.
