

**NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT
TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER
FY 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The purpose of this notice is to present amendments to the Township of Gloucester’s FY 2019 Annual Action Plan for the use of \$180,120 in Community Development Block Grant CV (CDBG-CV) funds awarded through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136.

In accordance with CDBG program regulations, the Township is permitted to make substantial amendments to its Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with their Citizen Participation Plan. The Township has determined that it is necessary to amend the approved CDBG program budget for the previously approved program year FY 2019 in order to address community needs that have emerged through the COVID-19 public health crisis. This qualifies as a substantial amendment in accordance with the Township of Gloucester’s Citizen Participation Plan.

The amendment to the FY 2019 CDBG Annual Action Plan is proposed as follows:
