**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 81 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER ENTITLED, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GLOUCESTER**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Gloucester, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that Chapter 81 of the Code of the Township of Gloucester be and is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 81-35A "Regulation for the Movement and the Parking of Traffic on Municipal Property and Board of Education Property" be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Municipal Property:**

**MAINSTAGE CENTER FOR THE ARTS PARKING LOT  
27 Black Horse Pike (C.R. 168)  
Blackwood**

**Regulations:**

1. General Parking
  - A. All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.
  - B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described here below, except in the areas covered by other parking restrictions.
  - C. Parking of vehicles, trailers, buses and recreational vehicles over three Tons Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) is prohibited at all times except for deliveries.
  - D. Parking of vehicles, boats or trailers with the intent to display for sale is prohibited at all times. Violators are subject to fine up \$1,000.00, subject to towing at owner's expense and/or imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days or by a period of community service not to exceed ninety (90) days.

2. Handicapped Parking

All stalls shall be 12 foot wide as shown on the attached site plan and signed with the R7-8 and R7-8P (Reserved Parking Sign and Penalty Plate), in the designated parking areas for persons who have been issued the Handicapped Parking Permits by the Division of Motor Vehicles.

3. Tow Away

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area, pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense.

Additionally, any vehicle parked between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operators' expense.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and provisions thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection or part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as required by law.
