**PUBLIC PORTION:**

1. **DISCUSSION OF THE 2018 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES – SET ASIDE GRANTS LAKELAND ROAD PEDESTRIAN – BICYCLE TRAIL** – Mr. Cantwell stated that Remington & Vernick would like to submit an application for a grant to extend the bike path in Lakeland for access to the County Bike Share Program. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
  
2. **DISCUSSION OF DESIGNATING DOWNTOWN BLACKWOOD AREA AS AN ARTS DISTRICT** – Mr. Carlamere stated the Mayor is interested in naming Downtown Blackwood, East Lake to Prospect, as an Arts District. This designation would assist with Arts grants for the Township.
  
3. **DISCUSSION OF INTENT TO PURCHASE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 120 E. CHURCH STREET** – Mr. Carlamere stated, in connection with designated Downtown Blackwood as an Arts District, the Township is interested in purchasing property located at 120 E. Church Street to create a parking lot for the area. Mr. Carlamere this would be completed via resolution in the future.
  
4. **DISCUSSION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 44 COLES ROAD** – Mr. Carlamere stated that the property has had possession of the vacant land at 44 Coles Road for several years. Mr. Carlamere stated that this property is going to be placed on the list of properties for auction coming up in the future.
