PUBLIC PORTION:

Mr. Mercado opened the public portion.

There being no comment, the public portion was closed.

1. **DISCUSSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR LOWER LANDING ROAD AND BLACK HORSE PIKE** – Mr. Chadwell stated that U.S. Vision approached the Mayor regarding traffic backing up on Lower Landing Road. Mr. Chadwell is proposing Remington & Vernick complete an application to the NJDOT to complete a traffic study of the intersection to determine the need for a turn only lane. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.

2. **DISCUSSION OF ASSIGNMENT OF POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT** – Mr. Carlamere stated he wanted to discuss with Council the contract with Gloucester Township for the installation of solar panels with both the Gloucester Township Public School Board and the Blackhorse Pike Regional School board with Marina Energy is going to be transferred to GSRP Project Holdings LLC. Marina is assigning their rights and revenues to this company. Mr. Cardis asked if this transfer also includes the solar facility located at Public Works. Mr. Carlamere stated that he would check, but believes the Public Works facility is also included. Mr. Carlamere stated that a formal resolution is not necessary. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
