

**GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
NOVEMBER WORKSHOP
NOVEMBER 5, 2018**

Mrs. Stubbs was absent.

PUBLIC PORTION:

Mr. Mercado opened the public portion.

There being no comment, the public portion was closed.

1. **DISCUSSION OF INSPECTION AND PERMITTING FOR GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP OWNED DAMS** – Mr. Cantwell stated that this agenda item also takes the place of agenda items 2 and 3. Mr. Cantwell stated that Lake Renee is due for its biannual inspection. Mr. Cantwell stated Remington & Vernick will conduct reporting to acquire the permit to lower the water level of the lake in the event of a major rainstorm. Mr. Cantwell stated that this reporting is submitted to the state for the annual permit to allow public works to lower the gate. The proposal for these projects is \$7,120.00. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
2. **ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR BLACKWOOD LAKE DAM SERVICES** – This was discussed under agenda item # 1.
3. **INSPECTION SERVICES OF THE LAKE RENEE DAM** – This was discussed under agenda item # 1.
4. **DISCUSSION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE INTERSECTION OF PETER CHEESEMAN ROAD AND COLLEGE DRIVE** – Mr. Cantwell stated that there have been resident requests for this project. Mr. Cantwell stated that this proposal is to do the studies, get the approvals, and prepare the plans to complete the improvements. The proposal for this project is \$13,800.00 and includes the study and design. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
5. **ERIK COURT** – Mr. Cantwell stated that the developer went bankrupt and the township pulled the bond. There were necessary improvements that have not yet been completed, that the township has taken over. These improvements must be put out for bid and include pavement, landscaping, and the basin. Mr. Cantwell stated the proposal is for \$28,500 and includes getting the contract documents ready. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.
6. **DISCUSSION OF A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE CAMDEN COUNTY TECHNICAL SCHOOLS DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION** – Mr. Carlamere stated a request came in for a resolution to enter into a shared service agreement with the technical school to utilize one full time officer, SRO, at their school.

COUNCIL LIAISON REPORTS:

Mr. Owens stated that an electrical strike hit the housing complex and put the building on fire watch. There is 1 vacancy in the entire building and the 2nd floor ac has been down since July with the part on back order. There are 2 openings for housing authority commissioners waiting to be filled. Mr. Mercado thought these positions were filled during the reorganization meeting. Mrs. Power stated that she will forward Mr. Owens and Mr. Mercado the appointment list. Mr. Mercado stated that the MUA has 1 position to be filled, but appointment must come from the Mayor's office.
