PUBLIC PORTION:

Mr. Mercado opened the public portion.

There being no comment, the public portion was closed.

- 1. DISCUSSION OF BICYCLE PATH PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE** – Mr. Chadwell of Remington & Vernick Engineers explained the pedestrian bridge requires replacement from damage sustained during a storm. After contact with the insurance company and the bridge manufacturer this discussion is for Remington & Vernick to prepare the bid package for this project. A straw poll was taken with all council members in agreement.

- 2. DISCUSSION OF AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 81 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”** – Mr. Carlamere explained that the amendment needed for this ordinance will allow the police department to ticket and tow in the specifically named apartment complex. Mr. Caralmere recommends this amendment to be placed on the next council meeting.
